

## **Diploma Course Description**

**Ed.ADM 301 Foundations of Education ( 3 credit hrs.)**

Identification of educational foundations. The content includes concept , Objectives, types, philosophy of education, and its relationship with schools of thoughts .

**Ed.ADM 302 The Educational System in Jordan ( 3 credit hrs.)**

This course aims to acknowledge the Jordanian edu systems' philosophy, goals, structure, cycles of development and changes in the system. Also, it covers briefly organizational structures, learning and teaching policies, educational cycles the system with some comparative views with other international educational systems.

**Ed.ADM 341 Introduction to Educational Psychology ( 3 credit hrs.)**

Learning and instruction, instructional objectives, development and individual differences, motivation, learning theories in classroom, learning models, classroom interaction, and characteristics of teachers.

**Ed.Psy 351 Introduction to Educational Research ( 3 credit hrs.)**

Characteristics of educational research, planning for experiments, the process of data collection, data analysis and presentation, using library, simple experimental designs, and theories of hypothesis –testing .

**Ed.psy 431 Educational Administration and School Supervision ( 3 credit hrs.)**

Principles and theories of educational administration; emphasis on leadership behavior in education and supervision.

**Ed.ADM 432 School Administration ( 3 credit hrs.)**

The role of principal and the school roles as a subsystem of the educational system; the content includes concepts definition. Focuses on school role related to community relations in Jordan.

**Ed.ADM 433 Practicum in Educational Administration ( 3 credit hrs.)**

He objective of this course is to provide students with administration skills with emphasis on concepts and practice.

**Ed.ADM 434 Principles of School supervision ( 3 credit hrs.)**

General principles of school supervision, its theory, development , definitions,. The content includes school supervision theory, principles of school supervision, the role of supervisor in developing teaching-learning process and supervision developmental plans in Jordan.
