STUDY PLAN FOR THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE & LITERATURE

The Department of English offers a Bachelor's Degree on completion of the following requirements.

- The fulfillment of the conditions stated in the By-laws of offering the Bachelor's degree in English Language and Literature.
- University course requirements (as stated earlier)
- Faculty of Arts requirements (as stated earlier)
- Departmental course requirements (87 cr. hrs.)

A) Single major course requirements (87 cr. hrs.):

B) Major/ Minor course requirements (66 cr. hrs.)

Students who follow this plan can have their major in English and minor in any of the other Departments of the Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Shari'a (Religion Studies), Faculty of Mass Media, and Faculty of Law.

1. Major in English courses (66 cr. hrs.)
 1. a. Obligatory courses (54 cr. hrs.), same as obligatory courses for single major above **except** E 451 & E 470A.
 - b. Two obligatory courses from other departments (6 credit hrs.): Tra. 202, Tra. 203.
 - c. Elective courses (6 hrs.) chosen from the elective courses for single major above, plus E 451 & E 470A.
2. Minor in any other Department to be chosen from among the following faculties: Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Shari'a (Religion Studies), Faculty of Mass Media, and Faculty of Law.

C) Course requirements for Minor in English (21 credit hrs.)

1. Obligatory courses (15 credit hrs.): E 101C, E 102C, E 103A, E 106A, E 202.
2. Elective courses (6 credit hrs.), chosen from the 200 level courses in the departmental B.A. study plan.
