

# **Bridging between the foundations of community colleges and universities of Jordan in the regular program and the parallel.**

## **First: (for Jordanian students).**

1. Considered eligible for admission to the official Jordanian universities about 20% of the first graduates in the medium-degree examination in each discipline have a counterpart in the Jordanian universities, except medicine and dentistry. Provided that there average not less in comprehensive exam at least 68%, except for students who wish to bridging disciplines of pharmacy and Engineering and Veterinary Medicine, provided that there average not less in comprehensive exam at least 70%.
2. 2nd May be accepted by universities in a competitive Jordanian official who passed the comprehensive examination of the public community colleges for the years prior to acceptance at more than 25% than in the first of the qualified acceptance of that year provided that the average in the comprehensive exam at least 68%, Except for students who wish to Bridging disciplines of Pharmacy and Engineering and Veterinary Medicine, Provided that there average not less in comprehensive exam at least 70%.

**Applications are submitted after advertising through the website to the Coordinating Unit for Common Acceptance.**

## **The program parallel / bridge for the**

### **A - Jordanian students**

- 1- The minimum rate in comprehensive exam not below 70% for engineering specialist.
- 2- The minimum rate in comprehensive exams not below 68% for the other specialists.
- 3- Similar specialist should be among Yarmouk University specialists.

### **B - Non-Jordanian students and students receiving a diploma of Jordanians from outside Jordan**

1. Ratification of documents from the competent authorities in the requesting state.
2. Equivalent to a diploma from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of Jordan.
3. To accept the complexity of examination-Balqa Applied University for students and non-Jordanians Jordanians holding a diploma from outside Jordan.

C - Equivalent courses are taught by college students on the school according to the plan in place and a higher (45) hours to a system for two years and (55) hours of the system of three years. The course mark is calculated in total and over 70%

- 1 - The original labels of the general secondary students who have secondary Jordan.
- 2 - A copy of the certificate of secondary signs of the Jordanian Ministry of Education for students who have secondary outside Jordan
- 3 - A copy of the disclosure marks the total certified by the Ministry of Higher Education and Research of Jordan.
- 4 - A copy of the certificate of the comprehensive examination of the Jordanian and non-college certificate, certified by the Jordanian Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of Jordan.
- 5 - Copy of certified birth certificate.
- 6 - A certified copy of the personal identity of the Jordanian students.
- 7 - A certified copy of valid passport for non-Jordanians.
