Introduction to SociologySOC 101Introduction to basic concepts and topics inSociology in terms of its rise and evolution;fields of sociology; relations of sociologywith other sciences, society, and with socialgroups, systems, organization anmdstructure.

Studies in Jordanian Society SOC 102

A number of studies that have been conducted on Jordanian society and related to historical, developmental, political, economic, educational, health, legal, family and demographic aspects visits to a number of developmental institutions in Jordan.

Family ViolenceSOC 103

Vmderstanding family Violence, causes and effect of family violence, violence against woman, violence against children .

Social Structure and Systems SOC 112

A comprehensive study of society; social structures and processes with emphasis on the factors of similarities and differentiation's; exchange, control and value building; clarification of intercommunications among social systems that regulate interrelations and mutual interdependence of social life with regard to family, education, religion, economy and politics.

Social Psychology SOC 214

This course cover the historic development of research curriculum social psychology, social upraising attitudes, values, dynamics of groups and leader ship. The effect of environment on social behavior, the relationship of social psychology with social works.

Sociology of family soc216

Family as a social system; development of family system; family functions; family research, theories and structure; historical changes; family patterns and impact of modern societies on family and kinship systems; marriage; origins of marriage; spread of marriage; forms of marriage; choice systems of marriage.

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Rural and Urban Societies SOC 217

Foundations of the rural and urban social structure; utilization of the data gathered about rural and urban population in defining the problems delaying their development and progress; rural: urban differences; problems of transformation of urban society with models and examples taken from Jordanian society.

Arab Social Thought SOC 222

Arab social thought before; Islam and its call for thinking; al: Farabi, ibn Sina, Abul: Ala AI: Ma'arri, Abu Hamid AI: Ghazzali, ibn Iskawayh; ibn

Bajah, ibn Tufayl, ibn Rushd; ibn Khaldoun; geographical travelers.

Social Theory SOC 225

Social theories prior to the 19th century, their linkage with the rise of the sociological theory as pronounced by auguste comte, karl marx, Herbert spenser, emile durkheim, max weber, trends of social thought, emergence of sociology schools.

JORDAN

Research Methods in Sociology

SOC 231

This course teaches students social scientific research; the use of scientific research in social studies; the ethics of social research; research tools and approaches in sociology; and the steps of scientific research starting from the selection of a topic, identify variables, data collection and categorizing and analysis.

Introduction to The Social work SOC 241

This course focuses on the philosophy of social work and its sciences. It covers structures, principles, methods, fields, communication and the importance of social service in Jordan.

Social work In Islam SOC 243

This course focuses on the Islamic perspectives of social work and the methods used for social problem treatment .

Social work and youth welfer SOC 244

This cource focuses on the role of the social worker dealing with youth welfare .

furthermore, it addresses related social work topics such as : philosophy,

goals, characters, and problems treatment.

Social work For The Elderly SOC 246

This course focuses on the Jordanian elderly in developed and the role of the experienced social worker to address problems related to the elderly.

Social Legistation in Jodan SOC 248

This course covers human rights and social law. It emphasizes the importante of the law dealing with family, children, employment, health insurance, disability, and social security.

Labor Social work SOC 249

This course addresses topics related to social work for employees, such as :concepts, philosophy, targets, methods employee education, union services, and social services on the community level and international level,

Social Problems SOC 256

Meaning of social problem; the social, economic and legal framework of the social problem; different types of social problems; unemployment; poverty; behavioral delinquency; racism; facing social problems.

Demography SOC 261

Growth of world population; geographical distribution of world population; fertility and births; deaths and emigration; relation between the growth of population and utilization of resources; theory of Malthus and later theories on family planning; applied study of some demographical methods with special emphasis on Arab countries statistics in general and Jordan in particular

Introduction To Philosophy SOC 281

Introduction to philosophy; ancient and modern introduction to the concept of philosophy; relation of philosophy to religion and science; topics of traditional philosophy; theory of knowledge (sources, nature and possibility), metaphysics or ontology; contemporary philosophical trends; Muslim philosophical thought; (scholastic theology, Sufism, philosophy of Islam); moral philosophy

Logic SOC 289

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Logic: evolution and branches; laws of thinking; propositions and kinds thereof; quadric division of propositions; logical terms; deduction and kinds thereof; direct and indirect deduction i.e. syllogism; logic of sciences.

Political Sociology SOC 317

Impact of sociology on the study of politics and administration with analysis of social aspects in political patterns; social bases of the state; of authority and power; political systems, social classes.

Social Change

SOC 318

Patterns and kinds of change; nature and social effects of change theories and studies related to change.

Organization S0ciology Soc 321

A comprehensive study of society; social structures and processes with emphasis on the factors of similarities and differentiation's; exchange, control and value building; clarification of intercommunications among social systems that regulate interrelations and mutual interdependence of social life with regard to family, education, religion, economy and politics.

Sociology of literature SOC 322

This course discuses the sociological study of authors of literature to benefit from the ideas of authors and men of letters related to the society .It also sets to link the literature with building the society so as to learn and acquire knowledge related to the society and to analyse the information sociologically and to compare it between socities are different in time and place .

Social Statistics

SOC 338

This course studies the statistical and analytical descriptive approach, samples, categorizing data and entering them, graphing data, standard deviation, frequency, residuals, correlations, and probabilities. The course also includes the role of statistics in social studies by linking the statistical approaches with experimental studies and its dependent and independent variables

Management of Social Institutions SOC 341

This course emphasizes the relationship between departments and management organizations in Jordanian social institutions, including structure and the management process.

Social work In Family Area

SOC 342

This course deals with family importance, needs, and functions Furthermore it addresses the social worker's role in solving family aggression and problematic children.

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Social work In The School Approach SOC 346

This course covers social work , its objectives , philosophy , methods of social work , relationship of school with the society , types school problems and the role of the social works in solving them .

Case work SOC 347

This course aims to investigate the individual cases- whether living alone or in a family – by the social work specialist to provide such cases with all kinds of support and assistance needed to enjoy healthy social relations, and help individuals adapt to their social or cultural surroundings. The course also introduces learners to the concept of interview; its stages and foundations. Emphasizing social and professional development of individuals with special needs is also part of this course.

Group Work

SOC 348

The purpose of this course is to study the group as a social unit , and fields of group work including youth care , individuals with special needs and encouragement of group individuals to take part in all activities out by the group as a whole. The course also aims at capitalizing on the role of experience in the achievement of intellectual and emotional of the group members and creation of a sense of responsibility towards the community.

Community Organization And development SOC 349

This course examines the community as a basic social service unit as well as the procedures adopted to coordinate existing social services and there development. The course also introduces various ways to create novel services in order to satisfy emerging societal needs for the purpose of the community welfare and the well- being of its members.

Social work in Social Defense Aria

SOC 350

This course deals with the philosophy, goals, principles and procedures of social defense.



Medical Social work

SOC 351

This course covers medical social work (goals, philosophy principles) the role of the medical social service, social perspectives for disease, medical training and medical training groups .

Culture and Globalization

SOC377

This course discusses globalization in general, its types, methods, and shapes as well as the culture of globalization. It also discusses the effect of information, satellite, and internet methods on the social values, social relations, and consumption behavior. In addition, the course will discuss globalization and the cultural identity of the society

Sociology of Knowledge

SOC 412

The method whereby the way of thinking is formed through social realities; form of knowledge and the method of studying social facts; testing facts and events in a certain historical period with emphasis on the contribution of

some thinkers to laying the foundations of this branch of knowledge

Social Text in English SOC 419

This course focuses on the social terms and concept ; in the English language and elaborates on topics such as the approach and field of social work.

Methods of Research In Social work

SOC 441

This course covers methods of research (planning, procedures, samples etc.), scientific definition, thinking, goals, purpose, characteristics, concepts and types (historical, empirical, dialectical) of scientific research.

Communication Skills In Social work SOC 442

this course covers communication skills in social work, its types, media, and scientific methods for human behavior analyses. Furthermore, it touches on people interaction and capacities for agreement

Social work For The Special Needs

SOC 443

This course covers rehabilitation of the special needs, stages and types rehabilitation, the rehabilitation team, role of social specialist, the relationship of the disabled with his family, institutions of integrating the disable in the local community

Special Topics in Social Work

SOC 444

In this course, students and the teachers selects special topics in social service which include contemporary social issues and problems. These issues will be discussed with students and field visits might be arranged to centers and institutions of social work.

Social Culture And Development SOC 447

Concept of social planning; necessity, requirements, policies apparatuses,

and stages of social planning; current classification of societies in term of backwardness and development; concept, constituents, dimensions

sectors of social development; planning for social development; sociological approach to social development; classical theories of development; social

development in contemporary sociological thought.

Medical Sociology

SOC 448

This course studies people's impression about health and illness as well as the health system as a part of the social system and its relation with other social systems. In addition, the course addresses the family and its relation with illness, and considers illness and health as social phenomenon.

Fields TrainingSOC 495

This course introduces the students to special educational practices in the field of social work and provides practical skills in teaching though applying theoretical practices in the classroom for all categories of the disabled.
